- To qualify for the part-time education amount, the student must have been enrolled in a specified educational program. Such a program must last at least three consecutive weeks and require a minimum of 12 hours of instruction each month on courses in the program.
- Do not enter the cost of textbooks on this form. Students calculate the education and textbook amounts based on the number of months indicated in box B or C below. See Pamphlet P105, Students and Income Tax, at www.cra.gc.ca/forms.
- Complete Schedule 11, Tuition, Education, and Textbook Amounts, to calculate the federal amount you can claim on line 323 of Schedule 1, Federal Tax; the maximum amount you can transfer to a designated individual; and the amount, if any, you can carry forward to a future year.
